1 Select plants to check for presence of pests and diseases



vegetable garden



native plants



parks and reserves



fruit trees

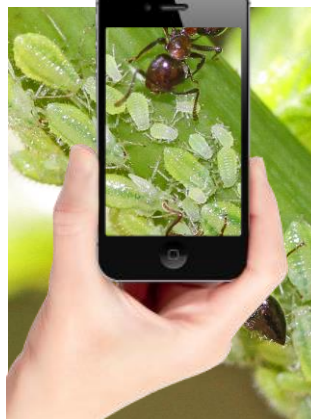
2 Photograph plants with insects, disease or damage symptoms



Take a photo of the plant in the landscape and three other photos including...



plant disease or damage,



insects or bugs present,



leaves or fruits.

3 Experts will identify the organisms and reply to you directly.

Every report protects WA from pests!

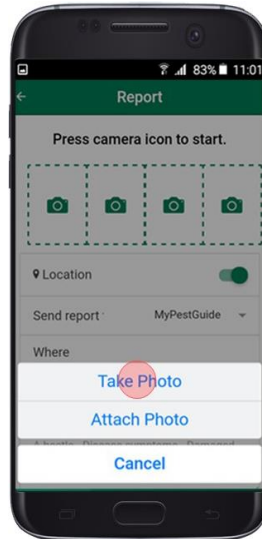

How to use MyPestGuide® Reporter

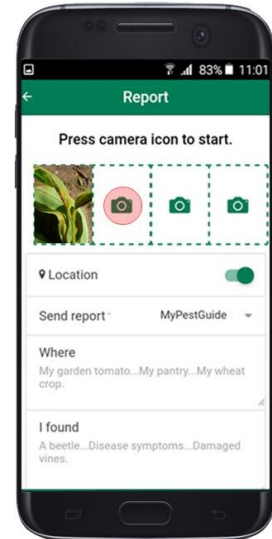

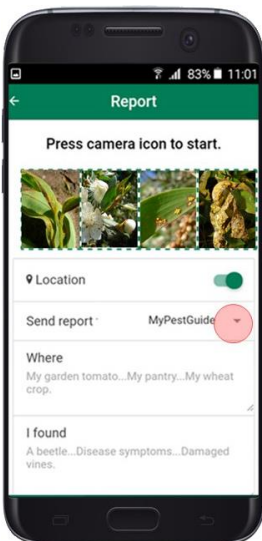
1 Create a report by pressing (+)



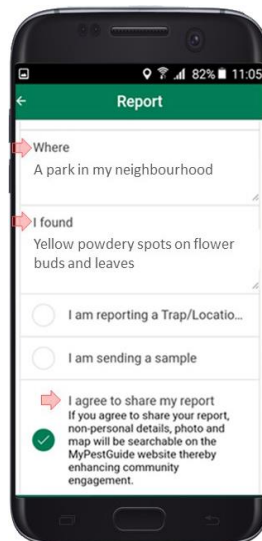
2 Take a photo with the camera, attach photos via gallery or photo share to app.



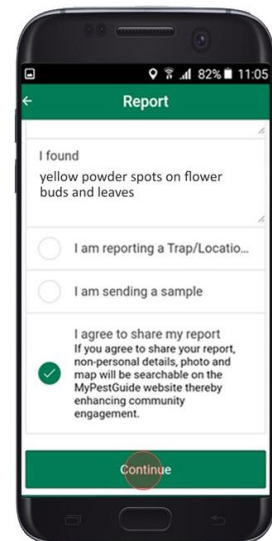
3 Add up to four photos to help experts identify the pest.



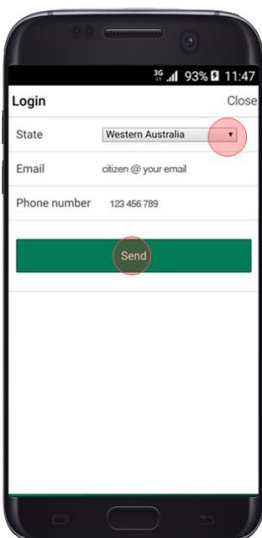
4 Check GPS is turned on and send to MyPestGuide or an invited project.



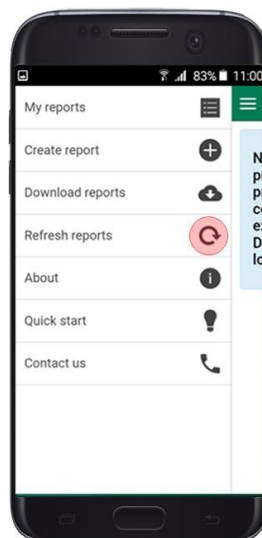
5 Add details of where and what was found, including host plants.



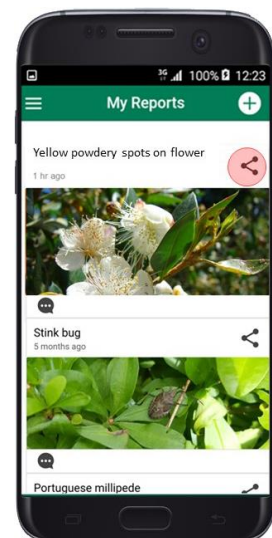
6 Default is to share a report, but you can choose not to, then press CONTINUE.



7 Select state, enter your contact details, send report.



8 Tap (≡) to refresh any offline reports. Pull down to refresh & see responses.



9 See all final reports on the home screen. Share on social media.
