

DPIRD accreditation: inspection and treatment of cattle/buffalo for movement into the Northern Territory cattle-tick control and/or free zone

Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013 (8A) and Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Quality Assurance and Accreditation) Regulations 2013

A person accredited by DPIRD:

- may inspect, treat and certify cattle at any cattle tick dip facility accredited by DPIRD for the WA intra-state cattle tick control program, provided they are not the owner, employee or agent of the owner of the cattle being inspected and treated;
- must not inspect, treat or complete section 5 of the NT health certificate for cattle that they own;
- must not inspect, treat or complete section 5 of the NT health certificate where they are an employee or agent of the owner of the cattle.
