

Form LB10: Declaration of re-entry

Ruminants and camelids returning to Western Australia within 10 days of departure

Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007 and Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013

This declaration provides evidence that the livestock described in Table 1 below are returning to Western Australia **within 10 days** of departing the State. It establishes the dates of departure and return to WA, and the interstate destination, to determine the pre-entry testing, and post-entry treatment and testing requirements for liver fluke.

Directions for this form:

- Complete Table 1 below and the declaration on page 2.
- This form is to be attached to the completed species-specific Form LB1: [Health certificate for movement of stock to Western Australia](#).
- Forms LB10 and LB1 should be emailed to the relevant WA Entry Inspection Point (below) at least 3 days before arriving at the WA border checkpoint and signed copies of the forms must accompany the livestock.
